Our Steering Group Vacancies

The following two roles are available as two-year positions. There may be the opportunity to extend this further after this period of time.

Events and Development Role

Encompassing events / CPD and our Resource management and generation the role will work as part of a team with Alison and Ed and will be jointly responsible for the outward facing activities for our work on a national level.

This role has a specific focus on:

- Co-ordinating CPD and Events available on a national level
- Ensuring that paid-for events are cost effective and are in-budget
- Sourcing funding/sponsors for large events
- Working with external events organisers to take advantage of opportunities to support teachers in our network
- Supporting the creation, sourcing and distribution of resources in a timely and proactive manner
- Work with external contacts to share resources relevant to teachers in our network

Champion Management Role

The Champion Management Role is a key part of our work.

This person will be the first point of contact for Champions and will support those new to the role to become established.

This role has a specific focus on:

- On-boarding new Champions
- Supporting launch events
- Providing a point of contact for existing Champions
- Answering Champions' FAQs
- Managing and updating the Champions' handbook
- Complete any admin for the monthly Champions' meetings, including organising and sharing minutes
- Possibly leading a team of Champions to support the wider network (if appropriate)

To apply, please write, audio record or video yourself giving your answers to the following three questions. This statement should clearly show your response to each individual question.

1. Why do you want to join the Steering Group of Open Drama UK? (150 words maximum or 1 minute) Please state which role you wish to apply for in this answer.

2. Why are you the right person for this role? (250 maximum or 2 minutes)

3. What would be the first thing you would like to do in the role you are applying for and why? (150 words maximum or 1 minute)

If selected for an interview, the interview will comprise of:

1. A short presentation (no more than 10 minutes) about your vision for the future of Open Drama UK; this can be live or pre-recorded.

2. A brief discussion about what you have presented, with the opportunity to answer any questions you may have.

All interviews will be conducted remotely, via Zoom.
